In her first multi-piece one-person exhibition, Jenny Perlin will exhibit four 16mm silent films, a new three channel video projection and drawings from several series. Investigating psychological self-help histories and their concurrence with Taylorist strategies for labor efficiency, Perlin connects various areas of contemporary life to challenge the compartmentalization of consciousness. Perlin's hand-drawn black and white films disarm with their beauty while quietly making a case for questioning the status quo. An MFA graduate of the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, Perlin also attended the Whitney Independent Study Program.
