Virtual Spaces is an exhibition of interactive virtual reality and electronic art created by the Electronic Visualization Laboratory at the University of Illinois at Chicago. Virtual Spaces presents new levels of exploration through the use of immersive electronic media. The works on display are designed for the CAVE, the Automated Virtual Reality Environment, and the ImmersaDesk system.
