Anything and Architecture Exhibition Celebrates Work By UIC School of architecture Alumni

(Chicago) The Architecture Alumni Association of The University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) will feature works by its members in an exhibition to be held at UIC's Gallery 400, 400 S. Peoria Street, Chicago from September 30 through October 26, 1996. The opening reception for the exhibition will be held on Wednesday, October 2 from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Gallery 400.

The exhibition, open to all alumni including those who attended the Department of Architecture and Art at The University of Illinois at Navy Pier, will highlight the various design and artistic talents which harbor beneath the professional veneer of the working architect.

The format established for the exhibition is limited to 6" x 6" two-dimensional and 6" x 6" x 6" three-dimensional.

The School of Architecture at UIC, having graduated its first students in 1967, now counts 2,000 alumni. The Architecture Alumni Association, established in 1985 provides support to the School of Architecture, most notably by having endowed an annual lecture series in which such distinguished architects have participated including the Spanish architect, Santiago Calatrava, Frank Gehry, and Peter Eisenman.
